

FROM THE PRESIDENT

Piers: Permits have been issued by all agencies involved. Contracts have been signed. Awaiting delivery of materials to begin the rebuilding process. Completion is estimated for the end of March.

Street Lights: They are being replaced as quickly as ordered parts arrive. Sun is trying to buy enough lights and/or total pole replacement units to maintain an inventory for future needs.

Locking of Lago Restrooms: Acts of vandalism have been to lock the restrooms in Club Lago meeting area. To lock the ladies' room in the gym area someone needed to crawl out of the room under a partition. Cameras are watching for future incidents.

Management will begin conducting the 2025 4-Wall Homesite Inspections starting **February 1st**. These inspections are an essential part of our commitment to upholding community standards and ensuring that our neighborhood remains safe, well-maintained, and welcoming for all residents. These inspections will be random and will begin with those that need the most attention. Please help us avoid the frustration of rule violations and attorney's fees by checking the state of your home and correcting any violations you may have.

HOME MAINTENANCE AND SAFETY TIPS

A question that sometimes gets asked is how often should I have my HVAC air ducts cleaned? You will probably be surprised to find out not that often. In most of our homes the vent registers are located at the ceiling, so there is little everyday dust that will accumulate in the duct system. Even after a remodeling or construction event, the need to have them cleaned is not as great if they were located in the floor, and therefore became filled with construction debris. If you feel a need to have your ducts cleaned, look for a company that is a member of the National Air Duct Cleaning Association. Low priced companies from a sales flyer should be avoided. The company should do an in-home inspection to quote you a proper price. One word of caution, most of the air ducts in our homes are located in inaccessible areas (the attic space). If any damage is done during the cleaning process, repairs will be complicated and expensive. Check in next month for information about HVAC air filters.
