FYI: The annual cost of the newsletter given you every month is more than the HOA dues of \$5.00.

Pedestrian Gate: A combination lock is being placed on the north gate pedestrian access gate. The combination is the same as the Rio pool locks. Unlike Rio pool, you cannot reach through the gate and pull the release bar to open this gate. Please do not share the combination on Facebook where non residents can see it. Call the office for the combination.

North Gate: Damage by another negligent driver has made the north resident entry gate inoperable. It will not open at night using your code. The cameras on the gates shows who damages them. They will pay for the damage by insurance or cash. We suffer due to their negligence. Some will blame Sun for the break down, not the careless drivers.

Channel 732 and 733: Both are not operating. Spectrum is correcting the problem. The information usually found there will only be available by asking the office or looking at our web site for part of it.

Street lights: Replacement and repair to a few street lights continues as parts and poles arrive.

PIERS: Material for construction of the north pier and repairing the south pier is in short supply. The contractors are waiting as we are waiting. Tiffany is inquiring about the contractors removing the ruined portions of the piers to be ready when the material does arrive. There is no expected date of arrival for the material.

FMO

Florida is home to hundreds of thousands who have chosen the lifestyle found in manufactured home communities and parks. Many live on fixed incomes without the ability to increase their income. In many cases our manufactured home residents are forced to choose between paying their lot rent or buying food and medicine.

PROPOSAL: During the 2025 Regular Session of the Florida legislature, the FMO will work to amend sections of Chapter 420 to assist manufactured home owners who own their homes that are placed on leased land with lot rent payments as we are here in Hacienda Del Rio. Assistance will be based on the home owner's financial need. Draft language to accomplish this has been placed with the Florida House and Senate Bill Drafting Offices. Specifics include and are not limited to:

Eligibility: Determination of eligibility to participate is outlined in Chapter 420, Part VII. Florida Statutes and specifically persons of very low income or moderate income who own their home that is placed on leased land will be added. The program will assist persons and households having incomes of not more than 140 percent of area median income and require proof of income, tax returns, Social Security benefits, or unemployment status to determine the level of assistance.

PROCESS: An eligible home owner must apply to the county or eligible municipality to participate in the Local Housing Assistance Plan to assist with lot payments.

The Local Housing Assistance Plan must provide an application process for eligible persons.

The Local Housing Plan must provide payment to directly lower the amount of lot rent for qualifying manufactured home owners based on their financial need.

Allow participants to renew for assistance annually, with updated income verification, to ensure that assistance continues for those that need it.

ACCOUNTABILITY: The Florida Housing Finance Corporation, (FHFC) must monitor local governments to determine compliance with program requirements.

Local governments must submit detailed reports to the FHFC each year by September 15.

Local governments must make the annual report available to the public for inspection and comment prior to submission. FHFC's compliance monitoring agent will determine compliance with program requirements.

The FMO supports home owner's concerns about lot rent increases. The FMO eliminates the discrimination that exists against manufactured home owners within the large conversation about affordable housing. When the bills have been filed and numbered in the House and Senate, the FMO will begin outreach efforts for support among legislators.

This is the point where the FMO needs your help. The more pressure that can be applied on each State Legislature will help increase support of this bill. Becoming a member of the FMO shows legislatures how many people support this bill. The FMO will have a list of all State legislatures in a future FMO magazine. The FMO strongly urges each FMO member to contact the legislatures asking them to support this bill. If you haven't joined the FMO now is the time. FMO member applications are available on the Club Rio HOA website (instructions to get on this website are in this newsletter). I will also have membership applications at future HOA monthly meetings. Important note FMO dues will increase from \$30.00 per year to \$40.00 per year and from \$65.00 for 3 years to \$70.00 starting June 1, 2025. Joining today will save you the price increase.

There are many reasons to join the FMO. The FMO is our only advocate in the State legislature. Among the accomplishments are: Expanded the Tie Down program to improve the safety and stability of manufactured homes; prevented the taxation of lot payments; secured a proven lobbyist to advocate on our behalf in Tallahassee; created the Consolidated Legal Fund offering HOA's the opportunity for legal representation and strengthened the protection under Florida Statute 723, giving homeowners greater security and rights.

The HOA strongly urges you to consider joining the FMO.
